

Schools and firefighters share \$25,000 Ulan gift

Ulan Coal Mines Limited has donated \$25,000 to local schools and bushfire brigades in the Mid-Western region.

The Community Support Program run by Ulan Coal, hopes to provides cash donations for equipment through the Local School Support program.

These funds are to assist with educational programs, new equipment, teaching supplies and presentation days.
